Is and Services by Patient Age

Services
No inpt pediatric beds
Adult Inpatient; Adolescent Unit
Inpatient (not locked unit)
Inpatient Services ages
Outpt age 0 - 23; Psych emergency Evaluation for age under 12
Inpatient & Partial Hospitalization (adults).
No emergency, crisis stabilization and short term hosp (~ 5 - 7 da)
Outpt svces only for pts discharged fr this inpt facility; psych emergency eval for age 12 - 17; crisis stabilization (pts brought in by 5150)
Intensive Outpatient Program: after school: (M,Tu,Th,Fr 3 hrs each time) individual and family counseling, psychiatrists. Esp for children/teens who are at risk of needing inpt hospitalization, eg self harming, substance abuse, failing intensive outpt tx (meds, psychotherapy)
18 beds total
Adult & Adolescent Inpatient; Adolescent Intensive Outpatient Program (after school M-F)
Inpatient children & adolescent
Inpt: Eating disorders only Outpt: Intensive Eating Disorder program
Evaluations only, transfer to inpatient if needed
Inpatient short term, voluntary inpt program for seniors.
